



Dorset Waterpark Schools Consent Form

Dorset Waterpark is an inflatable assault course spread over multiple lakes that also includes obstacles between trees. Participation involves swimming, swinging, slides and jumping from height.

Dorset Waterpark is a physically demanding activity and accidental injury is possible. Possible injuries include cuts, grazes, sprains and bone fractures, but more severe injuries can happen including loss of consciousness or drowning. Some situations may cause feelings of discomfort and fear.

Participants must be aged 6 or over and be more than 100cm tall. Participants must be able to swim 50 metres and be confident in the water.

It's very important that we know of any pre-existing health issues which may impact on your children's participation such as Back/Neck Injuries, Diabetes, Epilepsy, Respiratory, Cardiovascular, Psychological, past dislocation injuries or other health considerations affecting a participant's performance. You must inform a member of staff before your session if any of your children have any pre-existing health issues.

If appropriate, inhalers and epipens must be with your children on their session. If you would like any more information then please contact us prior to your session.
